Touro does not have Badgr Pro so this workshop will cover the basics of using Badgr (free version) with Canvas.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants will be able to create a badge. Participants will be able edit Canvas modules to add requirements for badges. Participants will be able add a badge to a Canvas course. Participants will be able to view the status of badge completion by students.

Badges can be given for completion of quizzes, assignments, or activities within Canvas modules.


